

Glad You Asked!

Q. I have heard that Treasurers are not officers in GWRRA, now I am hearing that they are. What's the deal here?

A. It is a simple answer. Treasurers, through 2010, were not considered GWRRA Officers. As of January 1st, 2011, several positions that were not considered Officers before are now considered GWRRA Officers. At all levels in GWRRA (International, Region, District, and Chapter), the following are now officers: Leadership Trainers, Membership Enhancement Coordinators, and Treasurers. Of course, Directors, Assistant Directors, and Educators have been and remain GWRRA Officers. To continue to elaborate on the topic of GWRRA Officers, there are new rockers that will be available soon that will be placed over the 4" Officer patch. They will say either "Region Team", "District Team", or "Chapter Team." There are lower rockers to designate "Director", "Treasurer", "Educator", "Membership Enhancement", and "Trainer." Note that Trainers exist at the District and Region levels, but not at the Chapter level. To conclude my response regarding GWRRA Officers, the change was made in conjunction with the Core Team concept for each level. It is appropriate that the entire Core Team (Director, Assistant(s), Treasurer, MEC, Educator, and for Regions & Districts, Trainer) are all recognized for the responsibility they share for their respective team, whether it be a Region, a District, or a Chapter. TEAM – Together Everyone Achieves More!
